

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-06**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW WATER AND SEWER RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICE SUPPLIED BY THE COMBINED WATERWORKS AND SEWER SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF WINNEBAGO, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND REPEALING CERTAIN PRIOR WATER AND SEWER RATE AND CHARGES ORDINANCES IN WHOLE OR IN PART**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Winnebago operates a combined water and sewer system within the Village, and has previously established rates for the usage of its water and sewer systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village engaged the services of Baxter and Woodman, Inc., to conduct a water and sewer study to conduct a cash flow analysis and cost of service evaluation of the Village water and sewer systems; and

**WHEREAS**, Baxter and Woodman, Inc., has determined that the current water and sewer rates do not provide funding for capital improvements for long-term sustainability of infrastructure and equipment, and the current rates charged cannot adequately provide for increases in costs for routine operations and maintenance of the water and sewer systems; and

**WHEREAS**, Baxter and Woodman, Inc., has provided the President and Board of Trustees with its recommendations for increasing water and sewer rates in order to provide funding for capital improvements and to adequately provide the funds necessary to meet the increasing costs for operation and maintenance of the water and sewer systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees have determined changes in the rates and charges for sewer and water are necessary, and new reasonable rates and charges need to be established in order to align with the current cost of service as determined by the aforesaid Baxter and Woodman, Inc., Sewer and Water Rate Study performed in May, 2011, and to distribute costs equitably among all customers, and ensure long-term financial and infrastructure sustainability; and

**WHEREAS**, a number of ordinances have been passed over the years providing for water and sewer rates established over a given time period, which ordinances have by their terms each provided that anything contained in a prior ordinance, including any amendments to a given ordinance, that was in conflict with a new ordinance passed was repealed; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 90-5 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the regulation and operation of the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, and repealing ordinances heretofore passed April 18, 1956, June 4, 1984, and March 7, 1988 pertaining to rates and charges of said combined system, and any and all amendments thereto", prepared by the Village's Bond Counsel, was passed on September 10, 1990, but said ordinance did not reference the specific ordinance numbers of the ordinances being repealed, and did not include the ordinances passed on September 23, 1949, April 25, 1977, and November 3, 1980, relating to Village water and sewer rates which should have been included in the repeal; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees feel it is in the best interests of the Village and its citizenry to enact a new sewer and water ordinance providing for the establishing of the new rates, repealing by specific number, in whole or in part, each of the prior ordinances wherein the rates established are no longer in effect, and including in the new ordinance certain non-rate provisions from

prior water and sewer rate ordinances, but providing for the repeal of those prior ordinances in whole or in part in order to have one resulting sewer and water rate ordinance in the interest of avoiding confusion.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Winnebago, as follows:

### **SECTION 1—REPEAL OF ORDINANCES**

The following ordinances, or parts thereof as indicated, with the following numbering, titling, and passage dates shall be and hereby are formally repealed and/or their prior repeal by Ordinance No. 90-5 is hereby affirmed:

**Ordinance No. 232--Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance Prescribing Water Rates for the Use of Water from the Municipal Water Supply System of the Village of Winnebago, Illinois"--passed September 23, 1949;

**Ordinance No. 277--Affirm Repeal of Section 2 and Section 3 only**--titled "An Ordinance Providing for the Regulation and Operation of the Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, Illinois, and Establishing Charges for Permit Fees and Inspection Fees Upon Connection to the Sewer Mains of said System"--passed April 18, 1956; (Note: Ordinance No. 90-5 passed on September 19 1990, repealed water and sewer rate ordinances of the Village passed on certain dates, including April 18, 1956, the date Ordinance No. 277 was passed, but did not reference the ordinance number. However, Ordinance No. 277 also dealt with the requirement of the applicant to pay for all costs of labor and materials required for installing sewer service, the authority of the President and Board of Trustees to make rules and regulations consistent with said ordinance for connection to the waterworks and sewer system, right of waterworks and sewer system employees to have access to premises to perform work, connection requirements after water or sewer facilities become available to subject property, and penalty provisions, so that is why the repeal of Section 2 and Section 3 only of Ordinance No. 277 pertaining to rates is being affirmed by the instant ordinance.)

**Ordinance No. 278--Affirm Repeal of Paragraph 1 and Paragraph 2 only**--titled "An Ordinance Establishing Charges and Rates for the Use and Service of the Combined waterworks and Sewerage System of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, Illinois."--passed April 18, 1956; (Note: Ordinance No. 90-5 passed on September 19 1990, repealed water and sewer rate ordinances of the Village passed on certain dates, including April 18, 1956, the date Ordinance No. 278 was passed, but did not reference the ordinance number. However, Ordinance No. 278 also dealt with lien provisions for delinquent accounts, and Village Treasurer accounting duties in reference to water and sewer funds received so that is why only the repeal of Paragraph 1 and Paragraph 2 of Ordinance No. 277 pertaining to rates is being affirmed by the instant ordinance.)

**Ordinance No. 77-5--Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance Amending Section 1 of an Ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance establishing charges and rates for the use and service of the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, Illinois as amended"--passed April 25, 1977;

**Ordinance No. 80-4--Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance amending Section 1 of an Ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance establishing charges and rates for the use and service of the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, Illinois as amended"--passed November 3, 1980;

**Ordinance No. 84-4--Affirm Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance amending Section 1 of an Ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance establishing charges and rates for the use and service of the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, Illinois, as amended'"--passed June 4, 1984; (Note: Ordinance No. 90-5 passed on September 19, 1990, repealed water and sewer rate ordinances of the Village passed on certain dates, including June 4, 1984, the date Ordinance No. 84-4 was passed, but did not reference the ordinance number.)

**Ordinance No. 88-2--Affirm Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance amending Section 1 of an Ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance establishing charges and rates for the use and service of the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County, Illinois, as amended'"--passed March 7, 1988; (Note: Ordinance No. 90-5 passed on September 19, 1990, repealed water and sewer rate ordinances of the Village passed on certain dates, including March 7, 1988, the date Ordinance No. 88-2 was passed, but did not reference the ordinance number.)

**Ordinance No. 97-10--Repeal in its entirety--entitled** "An Ordinance Increasing Water Hookup Fees"--passed September 8, 1997;

**Ordinance No. 00-04--Repeal Section 1--Water Connection Fees and Section 2--Sewer Connection fees only--titled** "An Ordinance Increasing Water and Sewer Connection (Hookup) Fees, Building Permit Fees, and Subdivision Review Fees"--passed April 11, 2000

**Ordinance No. 03-05--Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance Amending Section I and Section II of Ordinance No. 00-04 Entitled ' An Ordinance Increasing Water and Sewer Connection (Hookup) Fees, Building Permit Fees, and Subdivision Review Fees'"--passed November 10, 2003;

**Ordinance No. 06-10--Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance Amending Sections 2A and 2B(a) of Ordinance No. 90-5 Establishing Rates and Charges for the Use of and Service Supplied by the Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System of the Village of Winnebago, Winnebago County"--passed July 10, 2006; and

**Ordinance No. 07-01--Repeal in its entirety**--titled "An Ordinance Amending Section I and Section II of Ordinance No. 03-05 entitled "An Ordinance Amending Section I and II of Ordinance 00-04 Entitled 'An Ordinance Increasing Water and Sewer Connection (Hookup) Fees, Building Permit Fees, and Subdivision Review Fees'"--passed March 12, 2007.

## **SECTION II--RATES AND CHARGES**

**A. IN GENERAL.** The new rates and charges listed hereinbelow for the use of and for the service supplied by the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Winnebago shall be and hereby are established for water and sewer separately, with the rates for users outside the Village of Winnebago corporate limits being 150% of the rate for the given service for users within the corporate limits of the Village of Winnebago, and with such rates commencing at the beginning of the calendar year for each of the respective years listed, except for the year 2011, in which case the rates and charges shall become effective with the bill to be mailed November 1, 2011, covering the time period of September 15, 2011 through October 15, 2011.

**B. WATERWORKS:**

**1. WATER METER FEES.** Village resident customers must pay all associated costs for new water meter installation as determined at the time the connection permit application is submitted, and which are separate from connection fees referenced below. These costs shall include the material cost of the meter and necessary accessories, plus labor for installation and inspection. This water meter fee must be paid before the water service is turned on. For customers who are not Village residents, the cost shall be 150% of all associated costs for new water meter installation as determined at the time the connection permit application is submitted, as referenced above. The water meter shall be the property of the Village of Winnebago, but the user shall be responsible for maintenance of the meter and replacement of the meter for any reason, including but not limited to, willful or malicious damage, negligence, or damage sustained by freezing or caused by hot water backing through the same, except for the normal scheduled replacement of the water meter by the Village after the meter's normal life expectancy which is generally 14-20 years,

**2. WATER CONNECTION FEES.** There shall be and hereby are established the following water connection fees based on the size of the service and whether the person or entity connecting is a Village resident or non-resident, established with the intent to collect from each new customer that customer's proportional cost of constructing the water supply, treatment, and distribution systems, and with the goal that the growth pay for itself, rather than using revenue from existing customers to subsidize the cost of meeting additional demand from new customers:

The fees listed above shall not include any water used during construction. In addition to the above, a \$50.00 refundable deposit fee shall be due. Further, if there is no Buffalo Box in place on the premises, then in addition to the above costs, \$1,500.00 shall be due.

3. a) **MONTHLY FIXED WATER CHARGES.** There shall be and hereby are established the following fixed monthly water charges based on water meter size to reflect the increased demand placed on the water system by higher levels of usage, and to be assessed as a base bill whether or not a given customer uses any water during a given billing period, as the monthly fixed charges are structured to cover overhead and administrative costs that remain relatively constant, such as administrative overhead, utility management, meter reading, billing, customer service, replacement of meters on a regular basis, and government-mandated permit and testing fees, with such monthly fixed water charges based on whether the customer is a resident or non-resident of the Village:

b) A fixed water charge shall also be assessed to non-metered water services that are used only for fire suppression based on the size of the service.

c) No fixed charges shall be assessed for water if the water is shut off, voluntarily or involuntarily, for the period of time that the water is shut off.

4. **MONTHLY USAGE WATER CHARGES.** In addition to the above fixed rates, there shall be the following rates established to be charged for each residential, commercial, industrial, and municipal user of the waterworks service for actual usage, per 1,000 gallons, as stated below, based on whether the user is a Village resident or non-resident, with such rates in effect from the bill mailed

out November 1, 2011, covering the time period of September 15, 2011, through October 15, 2011, through services rendered through October 15<sup>th</sup> of fiscal year 2016, with such rates determined to be those necessary to meet the baseline expense projections for the Village incorporating into the Rock River Water Reclamation District and abandoning its current Waste Water Treatment Plant, and financing its incorporation into the Rock River Water Reclamation District through a combination of financing through a revenue bond and a low interest loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA):

**5. WATER SHUTOFF FEE:**

a) For any water bill not paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> of a given month for which a late fee of 15% as described hereinbelow shall have been assessed, and not paid by the time the next month's bill is sent out, a second notice shall be sent with the next month's bill listing the amount currently overdue, the late payment penalty amount, the Village's water service shutoff policy, and the customer's due process rights. If the overdue balance is not paid within 15 days of said second notice, a Village Public Works employee shall post a shutoff tag on the customer's front door, and a \$25.00 tag fee shall be added to the respective customer's account. If the overdue balance and all subsequent fees are not paid within 48 hours of posting the shutoff tag, the Public Works Department personnel shall shut off the customer's water service, this shutoff shall be considered an involuntary shutoff, and a \$100.00 shutoff fee shall be added to the outstanding balance. This shutoff or disconnect fee shall include one turn off and one subsequent turn on of the water by a designated Village employee. Delinquent customers must pay the entire past due amount, late payment penalty, and the total of \$125.00 in additional fees as outlined above before water service shall be restored. In the event turn on of water, whether for initial service or restoration of water service, is requested for scheduling at a time other than normal Village business hours, an additional fee of \$50.00 shall be assessed, and such fee, along with all other charges referenced above must be paid before the water is turned on.

b) In the event water is temporarily shut off at the request of the customer the shutoff shall be considered as a voluntary shutoff and the shutoff fee shall be \$50.00. This shutoff or disconnect fee shall, likewise, include one turn off and one subsequent turn on of the water by a designated Village employee.

c) The water account holder or his or her designated representative must be present and sign the Village work order at the time the respective Village employee turns on the water.

## C. SEWER

1. **SEWER CONNECTION FEES.** There shall be and hereby are established the following sewer connection fees based on the water service size and whether the person or entity connecting is a Village resident or non-resident, established with the intent to collect from each new customer that customer's proportional cost of constructing the wastewater collection, treatment, and discharge systems, and with the goal that the growth pay for itself, rather than using revenue from existing customers to subsidize the cost of meeting additional demand from new customers:

In the event street repairs will be necessitated due to the sewer connection, in addition to the aforesaid connection fees, there shall also be a \$2,000.00 refundable deposit provided that the owner or developer makes the necessary street repairs necessitated by the sewer connection within one year from the date of such connection. If such repairs are not made within the prescribed time period, the \$2,000.00 deposit shall no longer be refundable, and rather shall become the property of the Village of Winnebago, Illinois, to be used to make the necessary street repairs. In addition, the owner and developer shall be jointly and severally liable to the Village for any difference in the deposit amount and the actual cost to the Village to make the necessary street repairs.

**2. MONTHLY FIXED SEWER CHARGES.** There shall be and hereby are established the following fixed monthly sewer charges based on water meter size to reflect the increased demand placed on the sewer system by higher levels of usage, and to be assessed as a base bill whether or not a given customer uses any water during a given billing period, as the monthly fixed charges are structured to cover overhead and administrative costs that remain relatively constant, such as administrative overhead, utility management, meter reading, billing, customer service, meter replacement on a regular basis, and government-mandated permit and testing fees, with such monthly fixed water charges based on whether the customer is a resident or non-resident of the Village:

However, no fixed charges shall be assessed for sewer if the water is shut off, voluntarily or involuntarily, for the period of time that the water is shut off.

**3. MONTHLY USAGE SEWER CHARGES.** In addition to the above fixed rates, there shall be the following sewer usage rate established to be charged for each residential, commercial, industrial, and municipal user of the waterworks and sewer service for actual usage, per 1,000 gallons, as



stated below, based on whether the user is a Village resident or non-resident, with such rates in effect from when the bill is mailed out November 1, 2011, of fiscal year, 2011, covering the time period of September 15, 2011, through October 15, 2011, through October 15<sup>th</sup> of fiscal year 2016, with such rates determined to be those necessary to meet the baseline expense projections for the Village incorporating into the Rock River Water Reclamation District and abandoning its current Waste Water Treatment Plant, and financing its incorporation into the Rock River Water Reclamation District through a combination of financing through a revenue bond and a low interest loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA):

**D. LATE PAYMENT PENALTY**

A service charge of 15% shall apply to any outstanding water and/or sewer bill not paid in full by the 15<sup>th</sup> of a given month.

**SECTION III—RECORDING OF ORDINANCE**

A copy of this ordinance, properly certified by the Village Clerk, shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of deeds of Winnebago County, Illinois and shall be deemed notice to all owners of real estate of their liability for service supplied to any user of the service of the combined waterworks and sewerage system of said Village of Winnebago, Illinois on their properties.


**SECTION IV—REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES**
