Date Reported & Case #	Location	Description	Synopsis
4/1/16	Capriola Parkway	Informational	Officer stood by for a child custody exchange. This is an ongoing civil matter.
4/2/16	Prairie Hill Close	Burglar Alarm	Officer was dispatched for a residential burglar alarm. It was determined the alarm had been activated accidentally.
4/2/16	Elida Street	Burglar Alarm	Officer was dispatched for a business alarm. An unsecured door was located and a search of the premises was conducted. A responsible party was contacted and the door was secured.
4/3/16	Seward Street	Suspicious Person	Officer was dispatched for a subject who had approached a resident and asked for money for a friend who had a flat tire. The resident was not taken in by this ploy and reported the incident to the authorities. The suspect and vehicle were located, but denied asking anyone for money.
4/4/16	Stephanie Lane	Burglar Alarm	Officer was dispatched for a residential alarm. The residence was found to be secure. Contact was attempted with the homeowner, without success.
4/4/16	Elida Street	Building Check	While conducting building checks, an unsecured door was located. With the assistance of another officer the interior of the location was checked, and the door secured.
4/6/16	Elida Street	Informational	Officers responded for a subject resembling a suspect in previous thefts. The subject left prior to officer's arrival. Theft investigation is ongoing.
4/7/16	Benton Street	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a juvenile patient. The patient was transported to the hospital for further treatment.
4/8/16	Winnebago Road	Assist County Sheriff	Officer was requested to assist a Winnebago County Sheriff's Deputy on a traffic stop. The officer conducted scene security while the deputy investigated further.
4/9/16	Capriola Parkway	Disorderly Conduct	Officers responded regarding comments made to pedestrians by a passing motorist. The driver of the

			vehicle was identified and advised further actions such as this would not be tolerated.
4/10/16	Elida Street	Traffic Violation	Subsequent to a traffic stop, Bryon Shepherd (27) of DeKalb, IL was lodged in the Winnebago County jail and charged with driving while his driver's license was suspended.
4/10/16	McDamyn Circle	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital by ambulance for further treatment.
4/10/16	Elida Street at Cunningham Road	Traffic Violation / Warrant Service	Subsequent to a traffic stop for failure to stop at a stop sign, Jeremy Miley, (38) Winnebago, IL. was taken into custody and charged with operating a motor vehicle with a suspended driver's license, disobeying a stop sign, and served with an outstanding Stephenson County warrant for his arrest.
4/11/16	Elida Street	Vehicle Theft	Officer was dispatched for a report of a vehicle having been stolen. In speaking with the victim, who later wished not to seek criminal charges that the vehicle could have been taken by a person who had gifted money to the victim for the purchase of the vehicle. Further information provided by the victim indicated the vehicle may be at a specific location in the jurisdiction of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police. This information was provided to dispatch for follow up by a deputy.
4/11/16	Benton Street	Building Check	While conducting building checks, an unsecured door was located. A thorough check of the premises was conducted and the door was secured.
4/12/16	Soper Street	Medical Assist	Officer was dispatched to assist the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital for further evaluation.
4/12/16	Benton Street	Neighborhood Trouble	Officer was dispatched for ongoing issues between neighbors. The details of the incident were recorded, but no signs of criminal activity were present.
4/14/16	McDamyn Circle	Medical Assist	Officer assisted Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance personnel on a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital via ambulance for further treatment.

			uninvolved 3 rd party and could not be confirmed. Contact with alleged suspect was made.
4/15/16	West State Street	Juvenile and School Problems	Officer was dispatched for supposed bullying that was occurring. After talking with all individuals and uninvolved personnel, it was determined there was no credible evidence that any bullying was taking place.
4/15/16	Benton Street	Criminal Damage to Property	Officer was dispatched for windows broken out of a vehicle. The vehicle owner was not present, and was unable to provide a possible suspect or motive for the damage.
4/16/16	Mitchell Drive	Medical Assist	Officer was dispatched for a medical call. A parent self-transported prior to the arrival of emergency services.
4/16/16	McNair Road	Suspicious Person	Officer was dispatched for a suspicious person in the area. Upon locating the individual, it was determined the subject was walking home after visiting a relative in the area.
4/17/16	Pecatonica Road	Assist Winnebago County Sheriff	Officers assisted with a missing 3 year old child. Being first on the scene and upon speaking to persons present, it was determined the child had been located. Sheriff's Deputies investigated the incident.
4/18/16	Cunningham Road	Suspicious Person	Officer was dispatched for a report of noise inside a residence. Upon arrival, no signs of entry or foul play were observed. The residence was secured by the occupant. The surrounding area of the residence was also checked with no activity in the area noted.
4/19/16	Benton Street	Building Check	Officers conducting building checks located an unsecured door. Officers checked the interior of the location and found no signs of criminal activity. Officers secured the door upon exiting.
4/19/16	McNair Road	Suspicious Person	Officer was dispatched for a suspicious person. Even though the subject could not be located, the description matched the descriptions of previous calls regarding an individual who visits relatives in the area.
4/19/16	Highland Drive	Informational	Officer conducted a sexual offender check. The offender does not live at the location, and was advised no overnight visits could be exercised by the offender.

4/20/16	Winnebago Street	Burglary from Vehicle	Officer took information regarding a burglarized motor vehicle. The vehicle had been left unlocked and several items had been taken. This incident is under investigation.

4/21/16	Cannell-Puri Court	Informational	Officer took information regarding a civil no contact order. A report was generated.
4/21/16	Main Street	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance personnel on a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital via ambulance for further treatment.
4/21/16	Swift Street	Found Articles	Officer recovered items from a burglary from vehicle incident that had been found at this location.
4/21/16	Benton Street	Assist Other Agency	Officer assisted a Winnebago County Animal Services (WCAS) Officer investigating dogs running a large in the Village. The owner of the animals was cited by the WCAS Officer.
