12/1/15	Dickerson Drive	Assist Other Agency	Officer assisted with an Illinois Department of Children and Family Services investigation.
12/1/15	Elida Street	Burglar Alarm	Officer located an unsecured door while conducting building checks. A search of the location was conducted and a responsible party contacted.
12/2/15	State Street Rockford, IL	Assist County Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police with a disorderly subject.
