02/1/13	Elida Street	Theft under \$500	Officer responded to a call for a drive-off / failure to pay. No vehicle or suspect description was available.
2/2/13	Elida Street	Theft under \$500	Officer responded to a call for a drive-off / failure to pay. A suspect vehicle and suspect was described, but no further leads were available.
2/2/13	Capriola Pkwy	Stand-By	Officer responded to a call for a custody exchange. This is an on-going civil matter.
02/2/13	Matthew Court	Vandalism	Officer responded to a call regarding eggs being thrown at a residence. After conducting several interviews, a suspect could not be named.

02/7/13	Hwy 20	Assist County Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff Police with a reported reckless driver. The vehicle was observed committing multiple traffic violations. The vehicle and driver were stopped and held for Sheriff's Deputies.
2/10/13	Heeren Drive	Possession of Drug Paraphernalia	Officer conducted a traffic stop on a suspicious vehicle. Subsequent to the stop, Kitchrik Schmitz (18), Rockford, IL was charged with operating an uninsured motor vehicle, no driver's license on person and possession of drug paraphernalia.

02/15/13	Elida Street	Domestic Trouble	Officer took information regarding a domestic related incident. The reporting party did not wish to seek criminal charges regarding the incident.
02/15/13	Seward Street	Information	Officer documented an incident in which the victim did not wish to seek further action.
02/16/13	Landmark Drive	Burglar Alarm	Officer responded for a burglar alarm. Upon arrival at the location it was determined the alarm had been activated unintentionally.
02/16/13	Wallin Court	Information	Officer assisted a resident with a juvenile issue. No criminal action was pursued.
02/16/13	Cunningham Road	Traffic Violation	Subsequent to a traffic stop, a 17 year-old juvenile was cited for speeding more than 40 miles per hour over the speed limit, reckless driving and operating an uninsured motor vehicle.
02/16/13	Elida Street	Information	Officer responded to a reported drive off / theft of fuel. The responsible party was contacted and the debit was paid. This incident was deemed to be unintentional.
02/16/13	Capriola Parkway	Stand-by	Officer responded to an on-going civil matter. The incident was documented for court purposes.
2/17/13	David Drive	Medical Assist	Officer assisted medical personnel for an injured person. The Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance arrived on the scene and transported the victim to the hospital for further treatment.
2/17/13	Zierke Court	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance. The victim was later transported to the hospital for further treatment.
2/19/13	Main Street	Information	Officer met with a resident regarding harassing telephone calls and text messages. After speaking to all involve parties, an agreement was reached.
2/19/13	Swift Street	Suspicious Circumstance	Officer responded for a suspicious person. The subject was determined to be soliciting door-to-door without the appropriate permit, however the subject could no longer be located.
