7/1/15	Benton Street	Found Articles	Resident turned over property that was found on their property. The items will be held for safe keeping.
7/1/15	West State Road	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police on a domestic call. The officer secured the scene while deputies investigated the incident.

7/14/15	Winnebago Road	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for what was later determined to be a domestic battery call. A male subject was taken into custody by Sheriff's Deputies.
7/14/15	Michael Drive	Assist Other Agency	Officer assisted the Pecatonica Police Department for a domestic related call. The officer secured the

			scene while the Pecatonica officer investigated the incident.
7/15/15	West State at Meridan Road	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a subject who had fled from deputies. A perimeter was set up. The officer was later released from the area.

7/19/15	Main Street	Child Custody Dispute	Officer responded for a child custody exchange. Upon arrival, it was determined the parent and children were not present at the location.
7/20/15	Main Street	Child Custody dispute	Officer responded to a child custody exchange. The other party was not present and neither were the children. The complainant was advised to seek a remedy in civil court.
7/20/15	Elida Street	Retail Theft	An officer, while reviewing security video footage from a theft, was given information regarding a theft that had not yet been reported. It appeared both incidents may be the actions of the same person.
7/20/15	Benton Street	Disorderly Conduct.	Officers responded for a resident who reported a person in the street in front of their house, standing in the street yelling at them. The suspect was confronted and advised to leave the area.
7/21/15	Elida Street	Found Articles	Officer took custody of a credit card that was found. The owner was contacted and the property was returned to them.
7/21/15	Mallard Road	Trespassing	Officer received information regarding a property line dispute. The complainant was advised to seek action through civil court proceedings
7/21/15	Mallard Road	Theft	Officer received information regarding a theft of property. The compiled information was reviewed by the Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office,

			and no charges were filed. The property had been recovered by the owner.
7/21/15	West State Road at Falconer Road	Assist State Police	Officer assisted the Illinois State Police for a motor vehicle accident. A male subject was seen walking away from the crash scene, however, the subject was not located.
7/21/15	Winnebago Road	Assist Col. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a victim choking on food. Upon arrival the victim was conscientious and alert and no longer choking.
7/23/15	Main Street	Stand-By	Officer attempted to assist in a child custody exchange, but the children and parent were not home at the time.
7/23/15	Church Street	Welfare Check	Officer conducted a welfare check on 2 juveniles. They were located and found to be safe. The complainant was advised.
7/23/15	Clayton Court	Welfare Check	Officer conducted a welfare check on a juvenile. The child was located and found to be safe and sound.
7/23/15	Clayton Court	Illegal Consumption of Alcohol, Curfew	Officer issued 2 (two) juveniles notices to appear for consumption of alcohol by a minor. Parents were contacted and the juveniles were released to their custody.
7/24/15	Mallard Road	Informational	Officer responded for a temporary fence that was knocked down. The complainant named a suspect, but did not observe the person committing the act.
7/27/15	Mc Nair Road	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a medical call. The victim was later transported via ambulance to the hospital for further treatment.
7/28/15	Seward Street	Assist Other Agency	Officer took custody of a juvenile foster child who Lutheran Social Services of Illinois was coming to pick up. The juvenile was released to LSSI
7/29/15	Jessica Trail	Lock-Out	Officer assisted a citizen who had locked their keys inside their car.
7/29/15	Landmark Drive	Burglar Alarm	Officer responded for a commercial burglar alarm. The building was checked and found to be secure. The owner was contacted.
7/29/15	11 th Street, Pecatonica, IL	Assist Other Agency	Officer assisted the Pecatonica Police Department for a reported death. The victim was located and was deceased.
