This list is only a partial list of incidents the Winnebago Police Department has responded to and is not in any way all-inclusive.

Date Reported	Description	Synopsis
05/06/11	Battery & Disorderly Conduct	An officer was dispatched to Winnebago High School in reference to a fight between two students. One student was charged with battery while the other student was charged with disorderly conduct. Both students were transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Juvenile Assessment Center.
05/07/11	Driving on a Suspended Driver's License, No Insurance & Suspended Registration	Clayton L. Otto, Freeport, was arrested for driving with a suspended driver's license, and transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. He was also issued citations for driving a vehicle with a suspended registration and no proof of insurance.
05/07/11	Reckless Conduct	Zachary Grahf, Winnebago, was arrested for criminal damage to property, disorderly conduct, and reckless conduct and was transported to the Winnebago County Jail.
05/08/11	Warrant Service	Tina M. Hull, Freeport, was issued two citations for operating a vehicle with an expired registration and for not having a valid driver's license. Additionally, she was arrested on an outstanding warrant from Ogle County and transported to the Winnebago County Jail.
05/11/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to a complainant who reported that the tires of their vehicle were punctured. Two other similar cases in the area involving tire slashing are being investigated. Several people in the area affected were interviewed. If anyone has information regarding these incidents, please contact the Winnebago Police Department.
05/14/11	Obstructing Identification, Possession and Consumption of Alcohol by a Minor	An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was speeding. The driver was issued three citations for speeding, not having a valid driver's license, and illegally transporting alcohol. A passenger was charged with illegal consumption of alcohol by a minor. The driver and two passengers were also charged with obstructing identification and transported to the Winnebago County Juvenile Assessment Center.
5/14/11	Theft Under \$300	An officer responded to an incident involving theft. A resident reported that their mailbox had been removed from its post and could not be located. The mailbox was found several days later lying in a neighbor's yard.
05/15/11	Child Custody Dispute	An officer responded to a child custody dispute. The complainant was notified that this was a civil matter that does not require police involvement.
05/19/11	DUI & Driving on a Suspended/Revoked Driver's License	Pazzaz Breedlove, Rockford, was arrested for DUI and driving with a suspended driver's license. She was also issued a citation for speeding going 50 mph in a 35 mph zone. Dashea Harris, a passenger in the vehicle and also of Rockford, was arrested for illegal transportation of alcohol. Breedlove and Harris were transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
05/22/11	Domestic Battery	An officer responded to an incident involving domestic battery. Information was provided to the complainant on how to obtain an order of protection. An arrest warrant was issued.

Date Reported	Description	Synopsis
05/25/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to a complaint regarding a hit-and-run vehicle that ran over a mailbox. The complainant was able to provide information about a possible suspect. This incident is being investigated.
05/26/11	Criminal Sexual Assault	Officers investigated an incident involving criminal sexual assault. After a thorough investigation, there was no criminal activity apparent.
05/26/11	Criminal Damage to Property	A caller reported their mailbox had been run over and damaged. The officer noted three other mailboxes on this road in the same area that were also damaged. This case appears to be related to several other similar incidents that have occurred within the same time frame in Winnebago and is under investigation.
05/26/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer was dispatched in reference to criminal damage to property. The complainant reported their mailbox had been run over. Multiple incidents have occurred recently that have been similar in nature. A suspect has been identified and is being investigated. If you have any information regarding these incidents, please contact the police department.
05/28/11	Reckless Driving	An officer responded to a complaint regarding reckless driving. A description of the vehicle was provided. The officer located the vehicle and owner and gave him a verbal warning.
05/29/11	Reckless Driving	An officer responded to a complainant regarding a known driver who has been recklessly driving through their neighborhood and down the alley near their home. The officer spoke with the suspected driver and provided a verbal warning stating that the alley is not a thoroughfare.
05/29/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer noticed a mailbox lying on the ground while patrolling a neighborhood. It appeared to have been intentionally pushed over. The homeowner was advised. The police department continues to investigate several other recent incidents involving damaged mailboxes.
05/30/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer was dispatched regarding criminal damage to property. Minimal damage was reported but the complainant provided the names of two suspects. The officer spoke with the suspects but the case was unfounded.
05/31/11	Domestic Trouble	An officer met with an individual who reported domestic trouble and receiving harassing messages. An order of protection was obtained. The police officer contacted the sender of the harassing messages and requested that this behavior immediately end.
