Date Reported & Case #	Location	Description	Synopsis
11/1/15	Teal Drive	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police in serving an order of protection.
11/1/15	Main Street, Pecatonica	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police regarding a subject stumbling in the street. The officer conducted scene security while sheriff's deputies investigated.
11/2/15	Capriola Parkway	Child Custody Dispute	Officer was dispatched for a child custody exchange. The exchange occurred prior to the officer's arrival. This is a civil matter.
11/2/15	Butterfield Drive	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a residential alarm activation. The officer arrived and determined the residence was secure and no entry had been made.
11/2/15	Elida Street	Lock-Out	Officer assisted a citizen who had locked their keys inside their vehicle. Access to the vehicle was gained and the keys retrieved.
11/2/15	Goodling Street	Medical Assist	Officer responded to assist the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance. The victim was later transported by ambulance to the hospital for further treatment.
11/4/15	US Hwy 20	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police with a car vs. deer accident. The officer directed traffic while the deputy investigated the crash.
11/4/15	Clayton Court	Missing Person	Officer responded and took information regarding a missing person. An attempt to locate was broadcast.

11/4/15	Main Street	Child Custody Dispute	Officer attempted to mediate a child custody exchange. It was determined that the party asking for visitation did not have an appropriate place to host the children and the other party denied visitation. Both were advised of the civil nature of this issue.
11/4/15	Main Street	Domestic Trouble	Winnebago County Sheriff's Deputies assisted the Winnebago Police Department for a domestic trouble call. During the investigation, it was determined no physical violence occurred and one of the individuals chose to leave the residence for the evening. No criminal charges were sought.
11/5/15	US Hwy 20	Assist State Police	Officers assisted the Illinois State Police with a motor vehicle accident with injuries, about one mile west of Winnebago on U. S. Route 20. Officers tended to the injured person, secured the scene, identified witnesses and assisted in the direction of the REACT helicopter. The victim was airlifted from the scene with serious injuries.
11/5/15	Seward Street	Suspicious Person	Officer was dispatched for someone who had knocked on the caller's door. No suspect or vehicle was seen in the area at the time of the incident. However, a folding chair was found on the deck of the residence.
11/5/15	McNair Road	Building Check	Officer conducting a building check located an unsecured door. Contact was made with the custodian of the property and the door was secured.
11/5/15	Meadow Lane	Suspicious Person	Officer responded for the report of someone who knocked on a resident's door. The officer did a check of the area, nothing was found.
11/8/15	Seward Street	Disorderly Conduct	Officer was dispatched regarding a telephone call received by the complainant. The caller indicated he was the complainant's son. This was determined to be false. The call had been placed from a restricted number. The son confirmed he did not place the call. No further calls of this nature have

			been received by the complainant. The complainant further stated that the previous evening someone rang the doorbell to the residence. 3 folding chairs, not owned by the complainant were found in the yard.
11/6/15	Hawkins Drive	Criminal Damage to Property	Officer was approached by a resident, who wanted to file a report about some damage done to the siding of her home. The officer observed what appeared to be the impact of a paintball. No suspect could be identified.
11/6/15	Cannell-Puri Court	Child Custody Dispute	Officer was dispatched for a child custody exchange. The exchange occurred and both were told about the Child Safe Harbor Program. They elect to use a public venue.
11/8/15	Benton Street	Disorderly Conduct	Officer responded for soda cans that had been thrown at the window of a business. The offenders could not be located.
11/7/15	David Drive	Informational	Officer conducted a building check on what appeared to be an abandoned home. Dogs were observed inside the residence. The last known owner was contacted and the officer was advised someone would be checking on and feeding the animals.
11/8/15	Elida Street at US Hwy 20	Traffic Violation	Officer conducted a traffic stop for suspicion of driving with a suspended/revoked driver's license. Robert Geyer, (42) Freeport, Il was subsequently cited for driving while revoked, and operating an uninsured motor vehicle. He was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail in lieu of bond.
11/6/15	Benton Street	Disorderly Conduct	Officer was dispatched for tomatoes that had been thrown at the caller's car. The complainant only wanted the person spoken to. Case closed failed to file.
11/8/15	Clayton Court	Harassment by Text	Officer was dispatched for harassing text messages. It was determined the messages were social media messages and not directed at the complainant. The caller was advised to have the named person

			contact their local police department for reporting purposes.
11/11/15	West State Street	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a report of a domestic battery in progress. The officer conducted scene security while deputies investigated the incident.
11/12/15	Zierke Court	Burglar Alarm	Officer was dispatched for a residential alarm activation. The residence was found to be secure. It was determined the activation was related to the weather conditions.
11/13/15	McNair Road	Telephone Harassment	Officer was dispatched for a call that was received by a resident. The caller claimed to be the resident's son. However this was determined to be false. A suspect could not be identified.

11/15/15	Cannell-Puri Court	Warrant Service	Due to a tip, officers were able to take to juveniles into custody on outstanding warrants. Both were lodged in the Winnebago County Juvenile Detention Center.
11/13/15	Elida Street	Informational	Officer responded to assist the manager of a local business. Corporate security asked that an officer check the Automated Teller Machine to ensure a skimming device had not be installed on the machine. The machine was checked and no device was located.
11/16/15	Gregory Way	Suspicious object	Officer was dispatched for a suspicious box near a residence. It was determined the box contained coaxial cable wire left by cable installers at the residence a few days prior.

11/17/15	Cunningham Road at Westfield Road	Traffic Violation	Officer was dispatched for a 2 vehicle accident. Subsequent to the accident investigation, Tammy Lewis, (54), Winnebago, IL was cited for failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident and operating an uninsured motor vehicle.
11/18/15	Swift Street	Wire Down	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Fire Department for an electrical wire arcing. It was determined that due to the high winds, the wires were touching causing the arcing. Commonwealth Edison was advised and the fire department stood by until the situation could be corrected.
11/18/15	Montague Road	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police with a residential burglar alarm activation. Upon arrival, evidence of forced entry was found. Sheriff's Deputies are investigating the incident.

11/18/18	Swift Street	Motorist Assist	Officer assisted a citizen with their vehicle that broke down. The officer assisting in pushing the vehicle to a safe location until it could be towed from the scene.
11/18/15	Main Street	Welfare Check	Officer checked the welfare of a subject who was to be in distress. The officer made contact and found no indication the subject was in distress.
11/18/15	Elida Street	Burglar Alarm	Officer responded for a burglar alarm activation. An unsecured door was found at the location. The interior was checked and nothing unusual was found. The owner was contacted to reset the alarm.
11/19/15	Elida Street	Theft-Control of Stolen Property	Officer was contacted by a subject who had recently been the victim of a home invasion in Rockford, IL. The victim indicated a cellular phone was taken in the home invasion and they had been able to use the locating software on the phone to pin point the phones location. After a thorough

			investigation, Jesse Maldonato (19) of Hanover, IL was taken into custody and charged with possession of stolen property. He was then turned over to the Rockford Police Department for questioning.
11/20/15	Main Street	Disorderly Conduct/Assault	After a thorough investigation, the reported victims did not want to seek criminal charges against the suspect.
11/20/15	McNair Road	Missing Person	Officer responded for a missing person. The area was checked, but the subject could not be located. Later, the person was indeed located and found to be ok.
11/22/15	Pecatonica Street	Domestic Trouble	Officer was dispatched regarding the ownership of a vehicle. Both subjects provided differing details of the incident. Both were advised the situation is a civil matter.
11/23/15	Winnebago Street	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a fall victim. The officer arrived and assisted the citizen back into their house. The victim refused any further medical treatment.
11/23/15	Benton Street	Theft under \$500	Officer responded to the report of a stolen I-pad. A suspected was identified and subsequently, Melissa Adams (32) of Rockford, IL was taken into custody and charged with the theft.
11/24/15	Elida Street	Property damage only accident.	Officer responded for of a motor vehicle accident. While backing from a private drive, the vehicle struck another vehicle in traffic. Crash report completed.
11/24/15	School Street	Suspicious Person	Officer took information regarding suspicious activity. Reportedly mail was removed from a mailbox by an unknown person. The subject was identified and stated nothing was removed from the mailbox.
11/26/15	Bluff Street	Child Custody Dispute	Officer responded and took information regarding the exchange of children. The reporting party

			wanted the incident documented that the children were available, but the other party did not arrive.
11/26/15	US Hwy 20	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a motor vehicle accident at U. S. Route 20 and West State Street. The officer conducted traffic control while Sheriff's Deputies investigated the incident.
11/27/15	Soper Street	Medical Assist	Officer assisted medical personnel at a medical call. Win Bur Sew arrived and transported the subject to a hospital for further evaluation.
