| 11/01/11 | Warrant Service | Shane Thomas, 19, Winnebago was taken into custody on an outstanding warrant. |
| 11/01/11 | Disorderly Conduct | Officer was called for a disorderly student. Issue determined to be health related. No charges. |
| 11/03/11 | Reckless Driving | Officer responded for a vehicle driven through a yard. A description of a vehicle was given, but could not be located at the time. Later, a vehicle and driver were identified. Incident determined to be road-condition related. |
| 11/03/11 | Theft of Fuel | Officer responded for a theft of fuel. A vehicle description was given along with a license plate number. License number given did not return to a vehicle. Unable to locate the suspect or vehicle. |
| 11/03/11 | 911 Hang-up | Officer responded to a 911 hang-up call. Incident determined to be weather related. |

| 11/11/11 | Theft | Officer responded and determined there was not sufficient evidence to prove who took the item. |

| 11/13/11 | Theft under \$500 | Resident reported that a steel garbage can was stolen. Report was completed and no suspect was located. |
| 11/13/11 | Assist Other Agency | Officer was asked to assist the Pecatonica PD on a traffic stop. The driver was issued a Notice to Appear for the charge of possession of drug paraphernalia. |
| 11/14/11 | Battery | Officer met with individuals for an altercation at this location. A report was taken and forwarded to Juvenile Probation for review. |
| 11/16/11 | Medical Assist | Officer was called for a medical assist for a possible seizure. Win-Bur-Sew arrived and transported patient to the hospital via ambulance for further treatment |
| 11/16/11 | Assist County Sheriff | Officer was called to help with a deer that had been hit and was lying on the roadway. The officer dispatched the deer. |
| 11/18/11 | Child Custody Dispute | Officer responded and determined the issue was a civil matter to be decided by the courts. Informational report was taken at the request of the complainant. |
