10/1/15	Zearl Court	Disorderly Conduct	Officer was dispatched for words written on the sidewalk with organic material. The complainant only wanted the incident documented.
10/1/15	McNair Road	Informational	Officer was dispatched for a student entering another student's locker without permission. The student was counseled.
10/1/15	Landmark Drive	Burglar Alarm	Officer conducted a building check after hearing a burglar alarm sounding. The building was found to be secure.
10/2/15	Pecatonica Street	Informational	Officer spoke to a landlord regarding the actions of a tenant. The landlord was advised the matter is civil in nature.
10/2/15	Benton Street	Suspicious Person	Officer took information regarding an unsatisfied customer at a local business. The subject was asked to leave and did so.
10/2/15	Mallard Road	Suspicious Person	Officer was dispatched for a resident who had received a suspicious text message. The complainant was advised to block the person who called as it was determined the message was not meant for them.

10/3/15	Meridian Road	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for what was originally reported as a battery in progress. Further information indicated the subject may be armed with a gun. Officer secured

			the subject and determined no firearm was involved. Deputies investigated the incident.
10/3/15	Freeport Road	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police in locating a subject who had been reported to be bleeding, but walked away from the area. Air support was close by and was able to locate the subject. The subject was taken into custody on an outstanding warrant.
10/4/15	Mallard Road	Loud Music	Officer responded to a loud music complaint. Contact with the homeowner was made and the music was turned down.
10/4/15	Elida Street	Informational	Officer was dispatched to check the welfare of a juvenile who was overheard saying they were going to run away. Contact was made with the subject and parents. The subject indicated the statement was only made as a joke and had no intentions of running away.
10/2/15	Mallard Road	Lost Articles	Officer took information regarding keys that had been lost. The complainant was advised no keys had been turned into the police department.
10/5/15	Main Street	Missing Person/Juvenile	Officer took information regarding the reporting of 2 missing juveniles. The juveniles were located and were safe with their grandmother. The children had been with the grandmother the entire time.

10/9/15	Cunningham Road	Informational	Officer checked the welfare of 3 juveniles in the area. Parents were aware of their location and no problems were reported.
10/9/15	Landmark Drive	Informational	Officer checked on a vehicle parked at a business after normal business hours. The occupants were only talking. They departed when asked to do so.
10/10/15	7 th Street, Pecatonica	Assist Other Agency	Officer assisted the Pecatonica Police Department for a medical call. Upon arrival, an Illinois State Trooper was already on the scene with the Pecatonica Ambulance. The victim was transported for treatment.
10/11/15	Elida Street	Retail Theft	Officer was dispatched for the theft of 2 cases of beer. The complainant indicated a black male subject entered the store, removed wto cases of beer and return to a green Buick. The vehicle was last seen driving behind the business, through the open field and ditch onto U. S. Route 20. Incident under investigation.
10/11/15	Elida Street	Motor Vehicle Accident	Officer was dispatched for a 2 vehicle property damage only accident. Arnold Stolte, (67) Glen Ellyn, IL was subsequently cited for failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident.
10/11/15	Teal Drive	Burglar Alarm	Officer was dispatched for a burglar alarm activation. Upon arrival the building was found to be secure. The Win-Bur-Sew Fire Department was also dispatched due to a smoke odor. No fire was located. Contact with the homeowner was made.

			covering any child that would have been in the carriers. The subjects were in the store for a period of time. The subjects left hastily after being confronted by employees. No witness could confirm the subjects actually committed a theft.
10/13/15	Pecatonica Street	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital by the ambulance for further treatment.
10/15/15	Church Street	Criminal Damage to Property	Officer was dispatched for a fence that had been damaged. Subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Denise Case, (54) Winnebago, IL for criminal damage to property.
10/15/15	1 st St, Pecatonica, Il	Assist Other Agency	Officer was dispatched to assist the Pecatonica Police Department for a reported domestic related dispute. The officer provided scene security while the Pecatonica officer investigated the incident.

Subsequent investigation determined that no crime had been committed by any party as the incident was verbal only in nature. The family was provided resource contact information for family related issues.
10/17/15	Cannell- Puri Court	Possession of Cannabis	Officer was dispatched for a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot of a business. Upon arrival at the business, the officer found a subject asleep in the vehicle. Upon waking the individual, an odor of burnt or burning cannabis was noted. Rahber Kahn (25) Chicago, IL was subsequently taken into

			custody for possession of cannabis and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
10/17/15	Elida Street	Private property accident.	Officer responded for a motor vehicle accident on private property. A crash report was completed. No citations were issued due to the accident occurring on private property.
10/17/15	11 th Street Pecatonica, IL	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department for a medical call involving a pregnant female. The officer stood by until ambulance personnel arrived.
10/17/15	Mitchell Drive	Suspicious Person	Officer responded for the report of two male subjects inside the home of a family member. It was later determined the mortgage holder sent the individuals to change the locks on the residence due to foreclosure proceedings. No crime had taken place.
10/17/15	Cannell- Puri Court	Possession of Cannabis	Subsequent to a traffic stop and the odor of burnt or burning cannabis, Kenneth Comstock (19) Rockton, IL was issued a notice to appear for possession of cannabis.

The caller had exchanged information with the involved party, but had not obtained vehicle insurance information. The officer took the information and attempted to contact the involved individual.

10/23/15	Capriola Parkway	Child Custody Dispute	Officer responded for a child custody exchange. The exchange did not occur. This is a civil matter.
10/23/15	Clayton Court	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital by the ambulance for further treatment.
10/23/15	Cannell-Puri Court	Medical Assist	Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance for a medical call. The victim was later transported to the hospital by the ambulance for further treatment.
10/25/15	State Street	Assist Co. Sheriff	Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a domestic battery call. The officer conducted scene security while deputies investigated the incident.

			The complainant was advised to have the victim file a report with their local police department.
