ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF  
DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND PROVIDING A  
PENALTY FOR SUCH OFFENSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the  
Village of Winnebago, Illinois:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to make, aid or  
assist in making any improper noise, disturbance or breach of the peace;  
or to conduct himself in a tumultuous, riotous, or indecent manner; or  
while in the state of intoxication to lounge or wander about the Village  
or create any disturbance or be guilty of disorderly conduct; or for  
persons to collect in groups or crowds for unlawful purposes or for the  
purpose of annoying or disturbing any resident of or traveler within  
the Village.

Section 2: Any person or persons found guilty of the offense of  
disorderly conduct as herein defined shall be subject to a penalty of  
not less than Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00)  
Dollars for each offense.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its  
passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
