Burning in the Village Limits

The open or outside burning of natural deposits of leaves and landscape waste shall be permitted on private property where the leaves grew or were naturally deposited, or the landscape waste grew and/or accumulated between the hours of 3:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Leaves or landscape waste must not be burned in or upon public streets, alleys, sidewalks, driveways or other public property by anyone other than an employee of the Village. Public property includes the area from the middle of the street to 33 feet toward your residence. For everyone's safety, Please refrain from burning on public property.

At the August 9, 2010 Board of Trustees Meeting, the decision was made to discontinue wood chipping by the Village Public Works Department due to budgetary constraints. Limbs can be broken up and placed in a garbage can marked with an "X" for Gill's to pick up during the spring, summer, and fall months.
