Date Reported & Case #	Description	Synopsis
08/01/11	Warrant Service	Angela H. Barron of Winnebago was arrested for an outstanding warrant in Winnebago County with no bond. She was transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
08/02/11	Driving on Susp DL	Keleisha Milons of Kankakee was arrested for driving with a suspended/revoked driver's license. She was transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
08/02/11	Warrant Service	Cordell Watts of Kankakee was arrested for an outstanding warrant from Boone County. He was transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
08/03/11	Identity Theft	An officer responded to an incident regarding identity theft. The complainant reported that someone had fraudulently used their social security number.
08/03/11	Theft from Vehicle	An officer responded to an incident from a complainant who reported that someone had stolen their vehicle registration sticker from their vehicle.
08/05/11	Burglary from Vehicle	An officer responded to two separate incidents from complainants who reported that items were stolen from their vehicles.
08/08/11	Driving on Susp DL	Pilar Fekete, Winnebago, was issued a Notice to Appear for driving on a suspended driver's license. A citation was issued for failure to notify the Secretary of State of an address change.
08/11/11	Warrant Service & Poss. of Drugs / Paraphernalia	David Salazar, Belvidere, was arrested for having two outstanding warrants in Winnebago County and transported to the Winnebago County Jail. Salazar was also charged with possession of drug paraphernalia and cannabis.
08/11/11	Burglary from Vehicle	A complainant reported that several items were stolen from their vehicle, which was parked in their driveway and unlocked. It is believed that this occurred between 4 and 8 p.m. during daylight hours. Residents are reminded to ensure that vehicles are locked at all times.
08/15/11	Driving on Susp DL, Operating Uninsured Veh, Speeding	Edwin Cruz, Rockford, was arrested for driving on a suspended driver's license. He was also cited for speeding, going 58 mph in a 35 mph zone; operating an uninsured vehicle, and for not having a working registration light. He was transported to the Winnebago County Jail.
08/12/11	Domestic Trouble	An officer responded to an incident regarding domestic battery in which a 21-year-old male was being belligerent. No charges were filed.
08/14/11	Warrant Service	Shane Thomas, 19 years old of Winnebago, was arrested for an outstanding warrant for failing to appear in court and for possession of dangerous drugs.
08/17/11	Burglary from Vehicle	A complainant reported that his car stereo system was stolen from his vehicle, which was reported to have been locked.
08/18/11	Burglary from Vehicle	A complainant reported that someone had stolen several items from their vehicle which was unlocked and parked on the street near his residence.
08/19/11	Theft Over 300	A local business manager reported that a bank bag of money was missing and unaccounted for. This case is being further investigated.

	Susp DL, Oper Uninsured Veh.	license and was also cited for operating an uninsured vehicle. He was transported to the Winnebago County Jail.
08/21/11	Burglary from Vehicle	An officer responded to an incident involving burglary from a vehicle. The vehicle was unlocked and parked in the resident's driveway.
08/22/11	Domestic Trouble	An officer responded to an incident involving domestic trouble between a parent and their teenager. After speaking to all parties involved, the officer spoke with the teenager and explained the need to listen and conform to parental rules and that criminal charges could occur if violated.
08/22/11	Burglary	An officer responded to an incident regarding burglary of a garage. The complainant reported several items were stolen.
08/22/11	Burglary from Vehicle	A complainant reported that someone had stolen items from his vehicle that was unlocked and parked near his residence.
08/21/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to an incident regarding criminal damage to property. Two neighboring complainants reported that their mailboxes had been knocked down.
08/25/11	Burglary from Vehicle	A complainant reported that their vehicle had been burglarized. The vehicle was parked in the resident's driveway and it was reported to have been locked.
08/26/11	Tampering with a Motor Vehicle	An officer was dispatched to a residence after being notified that someone had tampered with their vehicle, placing vulgar messages on it.
08/28/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to another incident involving criminal damage to property and two neighboring residences that reported their mailboxes being knocked down. A description of a suspect vehicle was given but thus far has not been located.
08/27/11	Child Custody Dispute	An officer responded to a domestic trouble call involving an argument regarding visitation rights. Both parties were given information on Illinois domestic violence.
08/31/11	Theft Over 300	A local business owner reported that someone had stolen something from his property with an estimated value of \$3,000. It was later determined that it had not been stolen, but that miscommunication had occurred about someone picking up the item.
08/31/11	Driving on Susp/Revk DL	A Notice to Appear was issued to Shawn C. Gwaltney, Rockford, for driving on a suspended driver's license. He was also cited for operating an uninsured vehicle.
