Date Reported	Location	Description	Synopsis
02/05/11	W. State Road	D.U.I.	An officer observed an occupied vehicle in the ditch during inclement weather. Upon contact with the occupant, it was determined the operator was intoxicated. The occupant, Troy A. Collalti of Freeport, was arrested and charged with D.U.I. and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
02/06/11	Church Street	Driving on Suspended DL	An officer was made aware of a subject possibly driving on a suspended license. After thorough investigation, a warrant was issued for Daniel D. Heinen, 42 of Winnebago. Heinen was subsequently arrested on the outstanding warrant.
02/07/11	Benton Street	Passed School Bus Loading / Unloading	Information was obtained from the Winnebago School District Transportation Division that a school bus stop arm was violated during the loading and/or unloading of students. After complete investigation, Andria C. Wekenmann, 40 of Durand, was issued a citation for the violation.
02/07/11	McNair Road	Leaving Scene of Accident	Officers were called to the Winnebago High School in reference to a hit-and-run accident involving a school bus. Although the bus was not damaged, the offending party was located and advised of the requirements, responsibilities, and consequences of leaving the scene of an accident.
02/10/11	McNair Road	Theft from School Property	Winnebago police responded to the Winnebago High School regarding a student who had information pertaining to the theft of that student's I-Pod. An interview of a suspect was conducted but the investigation failed to prove the suspect had stolen the I-Pod.
02/11/11	David Drive	Criminal Damage to Property	A report was made to the police department regarding damage done to a vehicle while parked in the resident's driveway. It was determined the vehicle was not struck by another vehicle and no evidence was present that would lead to a suspect. The case was closed due to lack of investigatory leads.
02/11/11	Cannell Puri Court	Criminal Damage to Property	Officers investigated an incident involving a substance being spread throughout the interior of a vehicle. The offender was located and agreed to reimburse the victim for the cost of cleaning the vehicle.
02/13/11	Elida Street	No Valid DL	A traffic stop led officers to issue two traffic citations to Joshua J. Proehl of Freeport for driving without a valid license and operating an uninsured motor vehicle.
02/14/11	McNair Road	Battery, Disorderly Conduct	A call was received from Winnebago High School regarding a fight between two students. Both students were charged with disorderly conduct and taken to the Juvenile Assessment Center.
02/16/11	McNair Road	Battery, Disorderly Conduct	Officers responded to the Winnebago High School in reference to a fight between two students. Both subjects were interviewed along with an independent witness. One student was charged with battery and the other student for disorderly conduct.
02/16/11	Clayton Circle	Theft Over \$300	Officers were called regarding the theft of a wallet. During the investigation, a suspect was identified but could not be located. The suspect was later interviewed and denied taking the wallet.
02/17/11	Elida Street	Reckless Driving	A reckless driving complaint was made to the Winnebago Police Department. Officers investigated the incident but the complainant did not want to seek charges. The offender was located and advised of his illegal activity and the consequences that could occur if it was repeated.
02/21/11	Church Street	Domestic Battery	Officers were called to a residence regarding a domestic battery incident. At the completion of the investigation, a 16-year-old juvenile was arrested and charged with domestic battery.
02/22/11	McNair Road	Disorderly Conduct	Officers were called regarding students being disorderly on a school bus. The bus driver returned to school during her route and officers spoke to the students. Parents were later contacted regarding the children's activity on the bus.

Date Reported	Location	Description	Synopsis
02/24/11	Elida Street	Retail Theft	A local business reported finding several empty boxes of over-the-counter medication scattered throughout the store. Officers advised employees that adolescents are using this type of medication to "get high" and to be more vigilant in monitoring these areas. Some products were later moved to an area behind the counter making the medication less accessible.
02/24/11	Landmark Drive	Informational	A second business (this same day) called to also report that someone was removing contents from over-the-counter medication packages as employees are finding several empty boxes in the store.
02/25/11	Elida Street	Disorderly Conduct	An officer was dispatched to Ombudsman, an alternative school, in regards to a disagreement between two students regarding an I-Pod. One of the students agreed to return the I-Pod to its rightful owner the following weekday. No charges were filed.
02/28/11	Meadow Lane	Domestic Trouble	A juvenile was brought to the Winnebago Police Department in reference to possible abuse. The case was later determined to be reasonable parental discipline. No abuse took place.
