Date Reported	Location	Description	Synopsis
01/08/11	Mutton Drive	Domestic Trouble	A caller expressed concerns about harassing communications they were receiving. Further investigation showed no laws were violated. Case was closed.
01/09/11	Zierke Court	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to an incident about a vehicle that was vandalized. All four tires were flattened, a door sustained dents, and it appeared that a substance was poured into the gas tank. Investigation ongoing.
01/10/11	McDamyn Circle	Disorderly Conduct	A report was received regarding continued public urination. The suspect was identified and warned that further activity such as this would result in an arrest.
01/11/11	McNair Road	Domestic Trouble	An officer responded to a domestic incident that occurred at Winnebago High School between two students who are in a dating relationship. It was determined no crime had been committed; therefore, no charges were filed.
01/13/11	Elida	Warrant Service	A traffic stop resulted in the registered owner, Ryan J. Stalkfleet, 24 of Pecos, being taken into custody for an outstanding warrant in Ogle County.
01/14/11	Mutton Drive	Criminal Damage to Property	A report of a damaged driveway caused by a snowmobile was received. The complainant indicated a possible suspect. After further investigation, it was determined the suspect's snowmobile could not have caused the damage.
01/18/11	McNair Road	Disorderly Conduct	Officers responded to a fight involving two students at the Winnebago High School. Disorderly conduct charges were filed against the main aggressor in the incident.
01/20/11	McNair Road	Battery	Officers responded to a fight between two students that occurred at Winnebago High School. After interviews were conducted, one student was charged with battery and transported to the Juvenile Assessment Center.
01/21/11	McNair Road	Tampering with Motor Vehicle	Winnebago officers received information about school property that had been tampered with. The names of possible suspects were developed and interviews were conducted. Two students ultimately admitted to their involvement in this activity and were subsequently charged for criminal trespass to state supported property.
01/25/11	Elida Street	Juvenile & School Problems	Officers were called to the Winnebago Middle School for the investigation of prescription medication that was located in a duffle bag. The owner of the bag confirmed the intention was to give this medication to another student. The case was reviewed and it was determined that no charges would be filed. However, the student was disciplined by the school district.
01/25/11	McNair Road	Medical Assist	An officer was called to the Winnebago High School regarding a disoriented student. The student was subsequently transported to the hospital for further evaluation and treatment.
01/26/11	Hawkins Drive	Welfare Check	An officer obtained information regarding suicidal text messages. After investigating this, the individual who sent the messages was transported to the hospital for evaluation.
01/31/11	McNair Road	Delivery of Cannabis on School Grounds	Officers were called to the Winnebago High School in reference to the possible sale of cannabis by one student to another. The student was later arrested for possession of cannabis with the intent to deliver on school grounds. The juvenile was transported and lodged in the Juvenile Detention Center.
