This list is only a partial list of incidents the Winnebago Police Department has responded to and is not in any way all-inclusive.

Date Reported & Case #	Description	Synopsis
06/01/11	Reckless Driving	An officer received a complaint regarding reckless driving. A description of the vehicle was provided including the license plate number. The officer identified the owner of the vehicle and made contact with the individual stating that subsequent complaints of this nature could result in reckless driving charges.
06/01/11	Negligent Driving	An officer was dispatched in response to a reckless driving complaint. The witness provided details about the vehicle and was familiar with the driver. The police officer made contact with this individual and gave him a verbal warning.
06/02/11	Driving on Sups/Rev DL	Jeramie Dahlhauser, Rockford, was arrested for driving with a suspended driver's license. He was transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
06/02/11	DUI, Bac Over .08, Reckless Driving	Jess Filson, 19 years old of Freeport, was arrested for D.U.I. and was also given citations for having a BAC over .08, reckless driving, unlawful transportation of alcohol, and unlawful consumption of alcohol by a minor. He was transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
06/05/11	Domestic Battery	Alec Ramsey, Winnebago, was arrested for domestic battery and was transported and lodged in the Winnebago County Justice Center.
06/05/11	Retail Theft, Burglary	An officer responded to an incident involving retail theft and was given information regarding suspects. This case is being reviewed by the State's Attorney's Office.
06/06/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to an incident regarding minor criminal damage. The complainant reported that some landscape lights were found broken and scattered on the front lawn.
06/07/11	Fraud	An officer responded to an incident involving fraud to an elderly. The complainant reported that supposedly a government official called asking for money and making threats if the money was not received. The complainant was advised to have a trap put on their phone for any related future calls.
06/07/11	Theft Under 300	An officer met with an individual who reported that someone had stolen her debit card and made unauthorized withdrawals from her account. A 17-year-old minor was arrested and transported to the Winnebago County Juvenile Assessment Center.
06/08/11	Disorderly Conduct	An officer responded to a call from a complainant regarding criminal damage to property. Someone had thrown eggs at their home; however, there was no permanent damage.
06/12/11	Public Complaint	An officer spoke with a complainant who reported that a neighbor was seen urinating outside and that other neighbors had complained of seeing this in the past as well. The officer met with the suspect and advised him that if this were to happen again that he could be charged with disorderly conduct per a village ordinance. The suspect stated that he would end this behavior.
06/16/11	Burglary from Vehicle	An officer responded to a complainant who reported that someone had burglarized his vehicle after breaking a window to enter it.
06/21/11	Theft Under 300	An officer responded to a report of theft. The complainant stated that items were taken from her yard. There are no suspects at this time.
06/24/11	Domestic Trouble	An officer responded to an incident involving disorderly conduct. After investigation and finding no criminal acts, no charges were filed.

Date Reported & Case #	Description	Synopsis
06/26/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to an incident involving criminal damage to property. The complainant stated that he witnessed someone slashing the tire of their vehicle and was able to provide details of the suspect(s) and vehicles involved. Suspect information continues to be gathered.
06/26/11	Criminal Damage to Property	An officer responded to an incident involving criminal damage. The complainant reported that all the windows of his vehicle were broken.
06/27/11	Domestic Trouble	An officer received a report involving domestic trouble. The complainant provided a written statement and was given information regarding the Illinois Domestic Violence Act. No criminal activity occurred.
06/30/11	Theft Under 300, Criminal Dmg to Prop.	An officer responded to an incident involving theft. The complainant stated that yard décor items were taken from his property.
06/30/11	Reckless Conduct	An officer responded to an incident regarding reckless conduct. The complainant reported that someone had tampered with her mailbox causing an unknown substance and residue. Suspect information was unable to be provided.
06/30/11	Criminal Dmg to Prop. / Reckless Cndt	An officer responded to another incident involving the tampering of a mailbox.
