| 4/1/17 | Main Street | Battery | Officer was dispatched for a reported battery that occurred. After interviewing all the involved individuals, the victim chose not to seek criminal charges. |
| 4/1/17 | Winnebago Street | Informational/Medical Assist | Officer, assisted by the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police responded to a medical call. The victim could be heard yelling for help. The door to the residence was forced open and the victim located. The victim was transported to the hospital for further treatment. |
| 4/1/17 | Elida Street | Theft Under \$500 | Officer was dispatched for theft of motor fuel. It was determined the incident was unintentional, however the subject was located and the fuel debit was paid. |
| 4/1/17 | Soper Street | Open Window/Door | Officer located an open door at this location. It was determined the door had been left open accidentally |
| 4/1/17 | Cannell-Puri Court | Open Door/Window | While conducting building checks, an unsecured door was located. The location was checked, and the door was secured. |
| 4/2/17 | Seward Street | Informational | Officer was dispatched for a possible burglary to a residence. Upon arrival and further inspection of the area, it was determined this incident was related to an animal entering the location. |
| 4/3/17 | Main Street Pecatonica, Il | Assist Co. Sheriff | Officers assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a 911 call. Upon arrival it was determined the call was made in error due to a settings on a cellular phone, no emergency existed. |
| 4/3/17 | Benton Street | Neighborhood Trouble | Officers responded to a reported theft. Officers conducted interviews of several juveniles at separate locations. All were advised that further activity of this nature could result in arrests. Parents were notified. |
| 4/4/17 | West State Street | Assist Co. Sheriff | Officers assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a subject who had fallen from a vehicle |

The victim received a call from a subject indicating he was from the IRS and needed them to purchase a large amount of I-Tunes cards. The cards were purchased. The suspected called back and asked for card information. Contact with this agency was made at this time. It was determined the call was a fraud scheme to illicit money. The victim was able to obtain a refund all by \$50.00. |
| 4/5/17 | McNair Road | Traffic Violation | Officer was dispatched to personal injury accident. A report was taken. The victim only suffered minor injuries. |
| 4/4/17 | Landmark Drive | Medical Assist | Officer assisted the Win-Bur-Sew Ambulance on a medical call. The victim was transported by ambulance to the hospital for further treatment. |
| 4/5/17 | Prairie Hill Parkway | Welfare Check | Officer was dispatched to the check the welfare of a resident. The subject's vehicle was observed in the driveway running all night. Contact was made with the owner who stated they simply forgot the vehicle was running. |
| 4/6/17 | Elida Street | Retail Theft | Officer was dispatched for a fuel drive-off. A registration plate number was provided and contact was made with the owner. It was determined the incident was unintentional. The debit was paid. |
| 4/6/17 | Elida Street | Retail Theft | Officer were dispatched for a theft of motor fuel. The suspect had dropped the nozzle on the ground before leaving. A vehicle registration was obtained, but was not accurate. A suspect could not be identified. |

| 4/12/17 | Elida Street | Welfare Check | Officer was dispatched for a child left inside a vehicle. Upon arrival, the vehicle was gone. A follow up was conducted at the registered owners address. The child was found to be safe. |
| 4/12/17 | Elida Street | Lock-Out | Officer assisted a citizen who had locked their keys inside their vehicle. |
| 4/12/17 | Main Street Pecatonica, IL | Assist Other Agency | Officer assisted the Pecatonica Police Department for an in-progress retail theft. An unknown female was taken into custody and charged for the offense. |
| 4/10/17 | Dickerson Drive | Identify Theft | Officer recorded information regarding the unlawful use of the credit card. |

| 4/15/17 | Benton Street | Citizen Assist | Officer met with a resident whose vehicle had a flat tire. The complainant indicated the tire was damaged by a former acquaintance. The officer assisted in changing the tire and advised to re-contact the police if damage was found on the tire. |
| 4/15/17 | Winnebago Street | Welfare Check | Officer was dispatched for a welfare check on a juvenile. The child was reported to be ill and could not be available for a custody exchange. |
| 4/15/17 | Clayton Court | Harassment by Electronic Communication | Officer took information regarding messages the complainant had been receiving. No threats were contained within the messages. The complainant was advised to block all communication from the subject sending the messages. |
| 4/15/17 | Main Street | Disorderly Conduct | Officers were dispatched in regards to the return of a vehicle to the owner. Party's indicated the owner was intoxicated. The owner had brought another driver to remove the vehicle from the location. |
| 4/16/17 | Kelly Road | Assist Co. Sheriff | Officer assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a domestic related call. The officer arrived first and began obtaining information. Deputies arrived and took over the investigation. |

| 4/17/17 | Lakewood Drive | Assist Co. Sheriff | Officers assisted the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police for a domestic related incident. A suspect was to be breaking this in the residence. Officers arrived and found the male subject damaging |

| 4/18/17 | Cannell-Puri Court | Found Articles | Officer took custody of a wallet that was found at a local business. Attempts to contact the owner of the wallet went unanswered. |
| 4/18/17 | Main Street | Violate Order of Protection | Officer took information regarding and order of protection violation. Subsequent to that investigation, Joshua Montalvo (28) Cherry Valley, Illinois was taken into custody and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. |
| 4/19/17 | McNair Road | Informational | Officers conducted K9 sweep of the local school. They were assisted by Officers and K9's from the Illinois State Police and the Rockford Park District Police. No contraband was located. |
| 4/20/17 | Cannell-Puri Court | Traffic Accident | Officer investigated a minor traffic accident between to vehicles. Traffic crash forms were provided to drivers involved. |

| 4/21/17 | Main Street Pecatonica, IL | Assist Other Agency | Officer responded to assist a Pecatonica Police officer who was not responding to radio calls. The officer was found to be unhurt and not in need of further assistance. It appeared to be an equipment issue. |
| 4/24/17 | Elida Street | Theft under \$500 | Officer was dispatched for the theft of motor vehicle. Even though the reporting party was able to give a good description of the suspect, a vehicle registration plate was not obtained. Case closed for lack of investigatory leads. |
| 04/24/17 | Seward Street | Other Public Complaint | Officer made contact with a subject who was soliciting door-to-door. The subject was advised a permit was need to conduct this activity, and to cease further activity until a permit is obtained. |
| 4/25/17 | Bluff Street | Lock Out | Officer assisted a citizen who had locked their keys inside their vehicle. |
| 4/25/17 | Jarvis Drive | Fraud | Officer took information regarding a recorded message alleging to be from the Internal Revenue Service. The complainant was advised the IRS dose not contact people by phone and was advised not to call the number back or divulge any personal information to those placing the calls. |
