2/13/17	E McNair Road	Domestic Trouble	Officers were called to a local business for a domestic trouble incident. The officers spoke to all people involved, and explained that this matter is a civil matter, and would have to be handled by legal counsel.
2/12/17	Elida Street	Aggravated Battery of a Senior Citizen, Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer	Subsequent to a domestic battery investigation, William Rouse (48) Winnebago, IL was taken into custody and charged with aggravated domestic battery to a senior citizen. During the course of his arrest, he also battered the officer making the arrest. He was further charged with aggravated battery to a police officer.

2/13/17	Clayton Court	Welfare Check	Officer was dispatched to check the welfare of a juvenile. The child was found safe at home with a parent.
2/13/17	Elida Street	Battery	Officer was dispatched for a reported battery. After completing a thorough investigation, it was determined the initial information obtained from the reported victim was not consistent with other witnesses, and the reported victim had initiated the altercation.
2/13/17	Cannell-Puri Court	Hold Up Alarm	Officers was dispatched for a holdup alarm. Upon arrival, a cleaning person was found on the premises and had accidentally activated the alarm.
