7/1/17	McNair Road	Traffic Violation	Subsequent to a traffic stop Todd Spink (55) South Beloit, Il was taken into custody, cited for improper lane usage. He was taken into custody for operating during a driver's license suspension and served with an outstanding Ogle County Warrant.
7/2/17	Prairie Hill Parkway	Traffic Violation Investigation	Officer attempted to stop a speeding vehicle. The driver stopped in a private drive, exited the vehicle and fled the scene. Subsequent investigation led to the issuance of a warrant for Miguel Moorehead (20) Machesney Park, IL on charges of operating during a driver's license suspension, fleeing to elude and resisting/obstructing an officer. Morrehead was located and the warrant was served.
